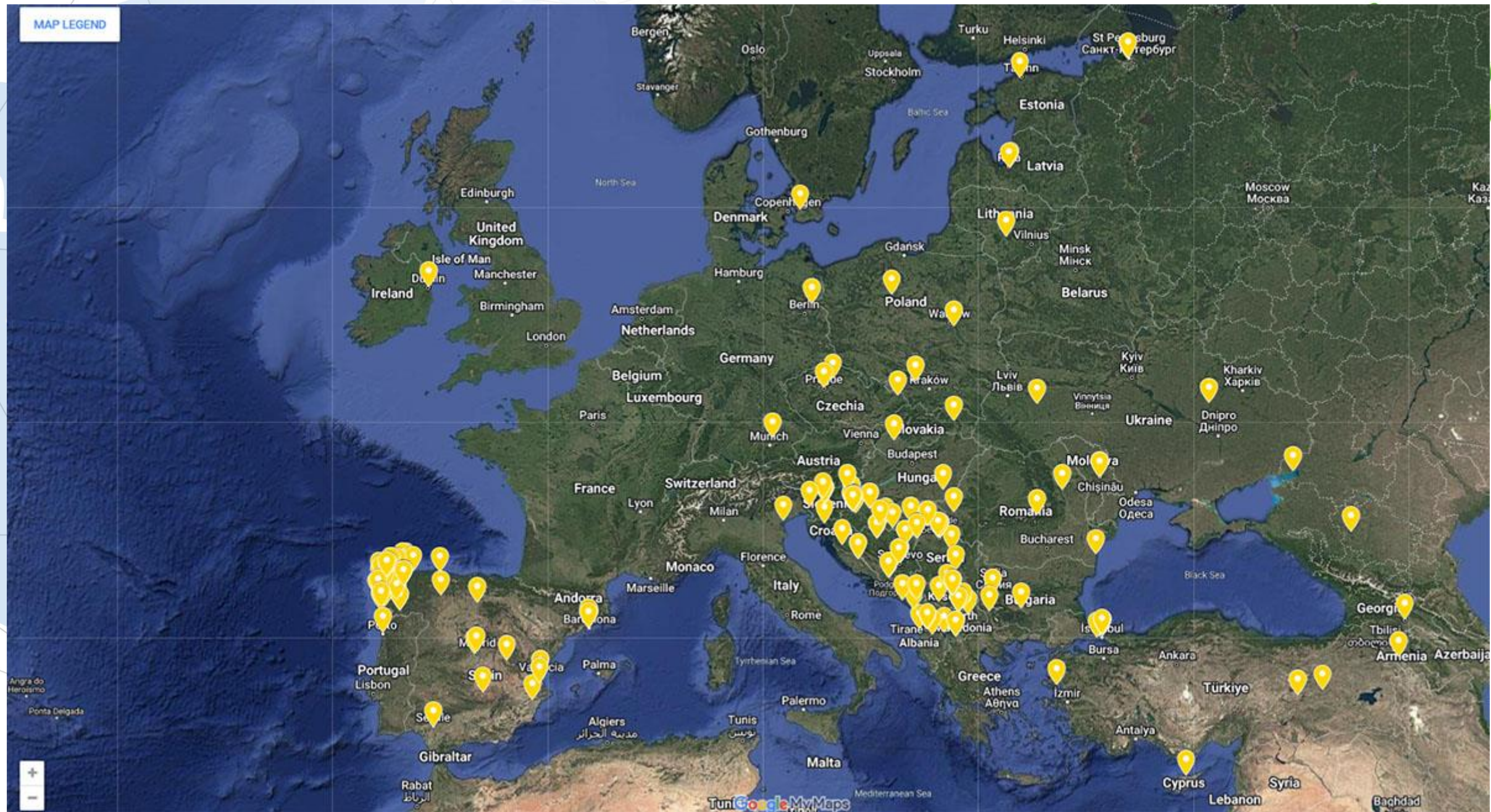

T4.2	Develop new study programmes at CEPS	CEPS will develop two Bachelor study programmes (180 ECTS and 240 ECTS) in Disaster Risk Management an integral part of the current Occupational Health and Safety and Fire Protection study program. This initiative aims to accredit and introduce a new study program direction within the existing program, which currently comprises two directions: (1) Occupational Health and Safety and (2) Fire Protection. The Disaster Risk Management curriculum will align with the initial five semesters of the existing programs. Upon completion of these semesters, students will continue studying in special courses tailored specifically for this new direction starting from the 6th semester. Thematic of the textbooks will be defined according to interdisciplinary nature of the green and sustainable development research field and partners will decide its content in consultations.
