
ETMI's mission is to advance sustainable development and territorial governance by:

GETA Project: Aimed to develop tools and new forms of training schemes to empower youth workers to become energy advisors and train rural youth with a purpose to make a smart energy transition of rural areas.

POWERING CITIZENS: Aims to empower energy poor citizens through tailored energy advice and dialogue, enabling them to participate in energy-related policies, claim their rights, and access information on energy poverty and solutions.

GREEN Project: Aims to develop participatory models for energy communities and promoting energy efficiency.

REMEDIES project focuses on three key areas: monitoring plastic litter, its collection and valorization, and preventing the spread of non-degradable plastics

RIVER CLEAN: Aims to promote plastic-free rivers, specifically targeting the Ishëm and Vjosa river basins, and the Adriatic Sea, by strengthening the participation of Civil Society Organizations (CSOs) in concrete actions aimed at protecting the environment and biodiversity.


JOINABLE aims at enhancing the development of a circular blue economy that is based on plastic waste collected from aquatic environments.
